# PART I

## BASIC PROVISIONS

### **Article 1**

#### **NATION**

The United Nation of Yisrael is a Theocracy (Governed by the Torah, which is the Law of YHWH) which embodies the cultural identity of the original/native people of the Earth/ Hephzibah Le Eretz Beulah / Hebrew-Israelites – a multicultural mixed multitude of citizens throughout the seven continents (North America, South America, Europe, Asia, Australia and Africa; including the adjoining Islands). The United Nation of Yisrael is governed by Rule of Divine Law which designates it as a Theocracy deriving its delegation of authority as a sovereign nation of Kings and Priests from YHWH(HYH), the Eloah of creation and progenitor of The United Nation of Yisrael over which he alone reigns supreme.

### **Article 2**

#### **SOVEREIGNTY**

The United Nation of Yisrael is a Sovereign Nation consisting of Sovereign individuals, organizing and exerting their own governances as sovereign people. It expresses sovereignty over all matters, both finite and infinite as they pertain to its aforementioned governance. Sovereignty is an unalienable right which cannot be relegated or diminished, to any degree, by anyone at any time. Citizens will exert these unalienable rights wherever they dwell and without the impedance of other Nations, **Dominions, Kingdoms, Commonwealths, Governments and Principalities** as long as said rights do not violate the laws and statutes of said entities.

### **Article 3**

#### **THEOCRACY**

The United Nation of Yisrael is a Theocracy.. It is a governing body created for the people by YHWH(HYH), a governmental prime directive conveyed by the Creator to the ancestors of the Hebrew-Israelites. It does not recognize foreign powers or admiralty over it. The United Nation of Yisrael shall conform to the Torah, which is the basis upon which the constitution rests.

### **Article 4**

#### **POWER**

The United Nation of Yisrael's power and authority are granted to it by the Most High YHWH the Creator of All. The United Nation of Yisrael shall be arranged according to the Torah. Judges and Officers shall be appointed by the Council of Elders and serve as arbitrators over all disputes or issues in accordance with the Torah (the first five books of the Holy Scripture B'reshit (Genesis), Sh'mot (Exodus), Vayikra (Leviticus), B'midbar (Numbers), and D'varim (Deuteronomy)).

## **Article 5**

### **THE NATION STATE SYMBOLS**

The United Nation of Yisrael shall have a national seal, a flag and a national anthem. The Nation will also have a male lion as a national symbol for the tribe of Yehudah (Judah) and a national plant the hemp plant.

## **Article 6**

### **THE CAPITAL CITY AND ADMINISTRATIVE CENTRE**

The administrative center and capital city of The United Nation of Yisrael shall be Yerushalayim (Jerusalem) of which we as a government and people are in exile. .

## **Article 7**

### **TERRITORY**

The United Nation of Yisrael currently domicile over all creation, existing before the foundations of the earth. Its citizens entered into the Nation by accepting the terms of the covenant presented by YHWH securing them as his people, the only family he has known, his children – sons and daughters of YHWH. Part and parcel with said conveyance and acceptance was the issuing of land to the ancient children of Yisrael who took possession therein in the fulfillment of time. This aforementioned land is an everlasting inheritance promised to the descendants of Abraham and delivered by the mighty hand of YHWH who led the ancient children of Yisrael out of Mitzrayim (Egypt). Contractually, the territory of The United Nation of Yisrael, as it is written, comprises the land mass between the Nile and Euphrates RIVERS. Due to the affects of the Dispora, The United Nation of Yisrael has now and will continue to acquire sovereign lands throughout the earth. The sovereign peoples of the Hebrew Yisraelite Nation will be given opportunity to bring any or all lands in their possession under the Sovereign Territory of the United Nation of Yisrael to be owned in allodium through our International Sovereign Land Trust.

## **Article 8**

### **LANGUAGE AND ALPHABET**

In the United Nation of Yisrael Hebrew will be the official language. The English language shall be deemed secondary but accepted along with any language spoken by the original/native people of the Diaspora.

## **Article 9**

### **CITIZENSHIP**

The United Nation of Yisrael shall confer Hephzipah/Hebrew-Israelite citizenship on its sovereign nationals/citizens. No Man or Woman may be deprived of the Hephzipah/Hebrew-Israelite citizenship or of the right to change citizenship. They may possess dual citizenship and/or nationality. In order to become a citizen of The United Nation of Yisrael the following methods are availed to the perspective immigrant:

- 1) Instant citizenship upon marrying a male Hephzipah/Hebrew-Israelite citizen.
- 2) Citizenship following prescribed naturalization process and circumcision for male immigrants
- 3) Citizenship following prescribed naturalization process for females who are not betrothed or espoused to a male Hephzipah/Hebrew-Israelite.
- 4) Adoption by a Hebrew family of a non-Hebrew child. Subsection 2 applies to adoption of non-male Hephzipah/Hebrew-Israelite children.

## **Article 10**

### **RELIGION**

The United Nation of Yisrael shall not observe a religion, but practice the Torah dictated culture of the ancient and indigenous Hebrew-Israelite; its laws, judgments and statutes.

## **Article 11**

### **LEGISLATURE**

The Torah, as it is written, prescribes and regulates the following, in harmony with the Constitution:

- 1) Circumstances in which rights and freedoms shall be exercised.
- 2) Manner of establishment, organization and competency of the Council of Elders and Officers the procedures through which it operates.
- 3) All matters of interest for the Nation.

## **Article 12**

### **LIMITS OF FREEDOM**

Freedom is granted, as it is written, by the Torah. Citizens are obliged to uphold the Torah and the Constitution. Judges and officials must perform their duties and shall be held responsible for their performance. Everyone shall be deemed to be free if not prohibited by law. Public officials must consciously and honestly perform their duties and shall be held responsible for their performance.

## **Article 13**

### **CONSERVATION OF NATURE**

In interacting with nature to promote one's own perfection, every person must respect the whole of creation. Each human being, a steward of nature, remains responsible for conserving natural forms of existence, each of which is interdependent and shares the same divine origin with humanity.

## **Article 14**

### **NATIONAL TREASURY**

All legal tender will be based on and backed platinum, gold and/or silver. The National Treasury will handle all matters of international and domestic monetary policy. The National Treasury will be responsible for the minting of all legal tender. The National Treasury in all matters answers to the Executive Council of Elders.

# PART II

## FREEDOMS & RIGHTS

### **Article 15**

#### **BASIC PROVISIONS**

Freedoms and rights shall be exercised in accordance with the Torah which is the basis of this Constitution.

### **Article 16**

#### **FREEDOM AND EQUALITY**

All citizens are free and equal regardless of any particularities and/or other personal attributes; equal before the Torah.

### **Article 17**

#### **INVIOLABILITY**

Freedom is an unalienable right. Everyone is obliged to respect the freedom of others. Abuses of freedom shall be considered a transgression of the Torah, unconstitutional and punishable.

### **Article 18**

#### **PROTECTION**

All citizens are entitled to equal protection of his freedoms and rights in the procedure prescribed by law. All citizens are guaranteed the right to an appeal against decisions made by the Council of Elders.

### **Article 19**

#### **LEGAL ASSISTANCE**

All citizens shall have the right to legal assistance.

## Personal Freedoms and Rights

### **Article 20**

#### **PERSONAL SOVEREIGNTY**

The integrity of a man, his privacy and personal rights, are indisputable. He is sovereign from birth. The dignity and freedom of a man are irrevocable, but subordinate to the Torah, as it is written.

### **Article 21**

#### **CAPITAL PUNISHMENT**

Human life is sacred. Capital punishment may be ruled and pronounced only for the most serious criminal offences.

## **Article 22**

### **RESPECT OF HUMAN DIGNITY**

Respect of human dignity is hereby guaranteed.

## **Article 22**

### **RULE OF LEGALITY**

No one may be punished for an act which does not transgress the Torah.

## **Article 23**

### **RIGHT TO DEFENCE**

Every person shall be guaranteed the right to defend himself and the right to engage a defense counsel before perspective Judges within the Council of Elders.

## **Article 24**

### **FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT AND RESIDENCE**

Citizens shall be guaranteed the freedom of movement and residence. Freedom of movement and residence may be restricted only for purpose of conducting criminal inquiries in which common law offenses have occurred. Restrictions may also be applied for prevention of contagious diseases or when so required for the defense of the Nation.

## **Article 25**

### **VOTING RIGHT**

Every citizen of The United Nation of Yisrael who has reached the age of accountability shall be entitled to vote on matters pertaining to the Nation. They may enlist in the Peace Keeping Force, but will not be eligible for election as Judge until elder status is conferred by the Council of Elders.

## **Article 26**

### **FREEDOM OF SPEECH**

Freedom of speech and of public appearance shall be guaranteed.

## **Article 27**

### **FREEDOM OF ASSEMBLY**

Citizens shall be guaranteed the right to peacefully assemble, in public areas, without prior approval. Freedom of association and other peaceful assembly may be provisionally restricted if there is a threat to security and/or common law violations.

## **Article 28**

### **INEQUALITY AND INTOLERANCE**

Any incitement or encouragement of national, racial or religious reprisal against an individual Hephzipah/Hebrew-Israelite or the Nation shall be deemed unconstitutional and punishable.

## **Article 29**

### **CITIZEN AND INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS**

Citizens shall have the right to participate in regional and international non-governmental organizations. Citizens shall have the right to address international institutions for purpose of protection of their freedoms and rights guaranteed under the Torah which is the basis for the Constitution.

# Economic, Social and Cultural Freedoms and Rights

## **Article 30**

### **PROPERTY**

Property shall be inviolable. No person shall be deprived of his property, nor may it be restricted except when so required by the Nation's interest, as prescribed by law, subject to fair compensation which may not be below its market value.

## **Article 31**

### **INHERITANCE**

The right of inheritance shall be guaranteed.

## **Article 32**

### **RIGHTEOUS EARNING AND COMMERCE**

Freedom of earning and freedom of Full and Open Commerce shall be guaranteed.

## **Article 33**

### **COPYRIGHT**

Freedom of creation and publishing all works.

## **Article 34**

### **PROTECTION OF ELDERLY and DISABLED PERSONS**

Elderly and disabled persons shall be guaranteed social protection.

## **Article 35**

### **STATE OF EMERGENCY**

All Citizens shall be obliged to participate in the prevention and elimination of threats during the course of a state of local regional and national emergency.

## **Article 36**

### **HEALTH CARE**

Everyone shall be entitled to health care. Amendments specifying the constraints and limitations of perspective health plans are forthcoming.

## **Article 37**

### **EDUCATION**

Everyone shall be entitled to quality education.

## **Article 38**

### **STATE AND ENVIRONMENT**

All Citizens shall act in rejuvenating and preserving the environment.

# Local Self-Government

## **Article 39**

### **LOCAL SELF-GOVERNMENT**

The right to self-governance shall be guaranteed to all Citizens who dwell in an intranational status (residing within the boundaries of foreign Nations) but shall remain subordinate to the Torah and common law ordinances. They shall possess sovereign immunity within the specification of the laws and statutes of the nation within which they reside.

## National and Ethnic Groups

## **Article 40**

### **EXERCISE OF RIGHTS**

Special rights granted to members of National and Ethnic Groups may not be exercised if they are in contradiction with the Torah and the Constitution.



# PART III

## ORGANIZATION OF THE STATE

### The Council of Elders

#### **Article 41**

##### **COMPOSITION AND ELECTION**

The Council of Elders shall consist of Judges and Officers appointed by the council on the basis of general and equitable Torah standards. Amendments specifying the overall structure of the seat and general distribution of Judges are forthcoming.

#### **Article 42**

##### **INDEPENDENCE OF DEPUTIES**

Every Judge shall decide and vote according to his understanding of the Torah.

#### **Article 43**

##### **IMMUNITY**

All Council of Elders members and Judges shall enjoy sovereign immunity. Judges shall not be called to account for an opinion expressed or a vote cast in the Council of Elders.

#### **Article 44**

##### **SESSIONS**

The Council of Elders shall sit in regular and extraordinary sessions. Regular sessions of the Council of Elders shall be convened two times a year, in accordance with the rules of procedure of the Council of Elders. The first regular session shall begin on the first working day after the last Feast Day. The second session shall convene before the beginning of the first Feast Day.

#### **Article 45**

##### **DECISION MAKING**

The Council of Elders shall decide if the session is attended by more than one half of the total number of Judges, and the decision shall be made by a majority vote of Judges in attendance.

#### **Article 46**

##### **COUNCIL OF ELDERS LEADERSHIP**

The Executive Council of Elders shall have no head. The Council will consist of an odd number of Judges counted for the purpose of equitable decision making.

## **Article 47**

### **ELECTION**

The election of Judges and State officials shall be transacted in a closed election format whereby all votes shall be made in private, counted in private.

## **Article 48**

### **INCOMPATIBILITY OF FUNCTION**

Foreigners may not serve as a Judge or perform any other public function if he is not a citizen of Hephzipah/Hebrew-Israelite descent.

## **Article 49**

### **COMPETENCIES**

The Council of Elders shall:

- 1) determine and conduct interior and foreign policy;
- 2) enact and execute laws and other regulations necessary for the enforcement of the Torah;
- 3) propose development plan, budget and the annual balance sheet of the Nation;
- 4) determine organization and manner of work of the Council of Elders;
- 5) perform supervision over work of administrations and authorities;
- 6) enact decrees and enactments during a state of emergency, in the event of imminent war danger or in the event of a state of war.
- 8) perform tasks as prescribed by the Torah and the Constitution.

## **Article 50**

### **PUBLIC TRIALS**

Trial before the Council of Elders shall be public. In exceptional cases only the Council of Elders may decide that the public shall not be allowed to attend a trial or any part thereof.

## **Article 51**

### **PERMANENT FUNCTION**

Judges shall have life tenure.

## PART IV

# CONSTITUTIONALITY & LEGALITY

### **Article 52**

#### **CONSTITUTIONALITY AND LEGALITY**

The Constitution must be in conformity with the Torah.

### **Article 53**

#### **INITIATING PROCEEDINGS**

All persons are entitled to initiate the proceedings of assessing constitutionality and legality. Proceedings before the Officers, Judges or Council of Elders shall be initiated by individuals after finding their rights or interest have been violated.

### **Article 54**

#### **DECISION**

The Council of Elders shall decide by a majority of vote of the Judges. The decision of The Council of Elders shall be generally binding. Decisions of the Council of Elders shall be published.

## PART V

# AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION

### **Article 55**

#### **PROPOSAL OF AMENDMENTS AND RADIFICATION PROCEDURE**

A proposal to amend the Constitution may be submitted. The proposal must include a Petition for Amendment signed by 1500 Citizens or a majority vote of the members of the Council of Elders. After which, proposed amendment shall be reviewed and decided upon by Judges residing.

## PART VI

### FINAL PROVISION

#### **Article 56**

##### **CONSTITUTIONAL LAW**

The United Nation of Yisrael shall uphold the Torah, as it is written, for the purpose of enforcing the Constitution. The Torah shall be adopted and deemed inviolable. It shall come into force simultaneously with the Constitution of The United Nation of Yisrael

#### **Article 57**

##### **COMING INTO FORCE**

The present Constitution shall come into force on the day of its promulgation.
